A lovely antique oil on canvas depicting a still life scene with vase of roses, signed lower right, 20 x 24in; the canvas is affixed to a wood stretcher, unframed

Eva Theresa Bradshaw, a prominent London, Ontario artist, 1871-1938; raised on a farm by her adoptive parents John and Marion Bradshaw, her family moved to an apartment east of Waterloo on Dufferin Avenue, where she would live for most of her life; Bradshaw was initially trained to be a nurse, and did not begin to paint seriously until she reached the age of 30; she trained with well-known still life artists John and James Griffiths, as well as Florence Carlyle, studied across the United States and eventually moved back to Canada where she exhibited regularly with the RCA from 1902-1907; her works are held by Museum London and many private collections across Ontario
