A large demonstration Wollaston Prism Goniometer by Duboscq-Pellin, Paris 1889 standing 18 inches high, constructed of bright and darkened brass on a cast iron base

Used to measure the angle between each face of the crystal, the crystal is mounted on the end and a beam of light is split by the prism; the angle is measured by two arms on a 360 degree circle, angles determining the type of crystal; other gem crystals and a mirror are included for teaching the angles of the facets, an extremely rare item
