A 4-inch silvered compass in 5 x 5in mahogany case by J. Davis of Derby, UK, 8 cardinal points divided by 4 32-hour outer rings (N.B. one hour = 15 degrees); extremely rare and fine, perfect silvered dial, jeweled pivot point, working and locks by pin when lid closed; both hooks on square mahogany case with brass hinges; sometimes referred to as a miner's compass
