### Description

An original carburetor from a P-39 Airacobra fighter plane, which was found by a diver in the St. Clair River near Port Lambton; professionally sandblasted, sealed and mounted by RM on oak display stand measuring 15 x 12in, overall height 14in; the Bell P-39 Airacobra was a fighter plane produced by Bell Aircraft for the United States Air Force during World War II

NOTE: from a private Chatham, Ontario collection, a friend of the current owner was a diver and found the plane wreck in the St. Clair River (which is still there today) near Port Lambton off Dickinson Island, a unique item and interesting piece of history
